*Morning Excursion in Sydney - Organised by Jim Munro*

Dear Delegates

Marilyn and I are organising a Sydney tour for those coming to Sydney before the IECEx meetings in Melbourne. We would appreciate an indication of whether you are interested.

We plan to run a morning tour on Friday, 28 August. This will complete in time for those planning to go to TestSafe. We tried out the itinerary yesterday and it seemed to work. It will probably be as follows:

- We will meet you in the foyer of Rydges in Sydney – probably **8.15 a.m.**
- Travel by train and bus through the Eastern suburbs of Sydney.
- Commence an easy stroll of a few kms at Tamara beach along the beach and cliffs on a good path to our famous Bondi Beach. This will be a good opportunity to see the fabled Australian beaches and coastal scenery.
- Stroll along Bondi Beach with a chance to dip your toes in the water of the Tasman Sea/Pacific Ocean.
- Catch a bus to Watsons Bay.
- But some fish and chips or similar from our well known Doyles and eat them on in the café area on the wharf surrounded on three sides by Sydney Harbour and a variety of boats.
- Catch the ferry to Circular Quay. We will pass close to the Opera House and the Sydney Harbour Bridge.
- Travel back to Rydges for those heading to TestSafe. We plan to be there by 12.45 pm.

The only cost for the above is \$17 for your ticket that will get you onto trains, buses and ferries; plus the cost of your lunch.

For those who would like to stay on in the city (including spouses and children of those going to TestSafe). We will run a tour within Sydney. Possibly visiting the rocks and taking another ferry to Darling Harbour.
