Scope of presentation/workshop

- Test and assessment data that can appear in a ExTR report that is endorsed by an ExCB and issued by an ExTL
- Above ExTR supporting issue of an IECEx CoC.
- Initially look at the situation from the ExTR perspective
- Later introduce possible difference from ExCB perspective

What do the rules say?

- IECEx 02
- 8.2 IECEx Test Report (ExTR)
- 8.2.1 Preparation
- An ExTR is prepared and issued by an ExTL but must be endorsed by an ExCB, associated with the ExTL, recording the product design assessment, examination and assessment and testing work carried out in order to verify the conformity of Ex equipment with the requirements of the stated standards. An allocated part of the front cover sheet of the ExTR or a separate sheet may be used by the ExCB for endorsing the ExTR.

IECEx02

- 9.4 Examination of documentation and assessment/testing of samples
- The ExCB shall arrange for its associated ExTL to examine the documentation and the sample(s) to verify that the Ex equipment design is in conformity with the standard(s). The ExTL shall examine the sample(s) for compliance with the documentation, test the sample(s) as specified in the standard(s) and compile an ExTR.

Potential sources of test and assessment data

- ExTL
- ATF (Additional Test Facility)
- Manufacturer of product submitted
- Subcontracted laboratory
- Witness testing (OD 024)
- Documentation

How is above addressed in IECEx?

Assessments

- All bodies producing test data for use in ExTR must have been assessed:
 - ExTL by IECEx assessment team
 - ATF by IECEx assessment team
 - Bodies covered by OD 024 by ExTL/ExCB
 - Subcontracted tests by ExTL/ExCB but may rely on national accreditation or IECEE assessment

- ExTR is drafted by ATF, including assessment of compliance with standards (within scope)
- ExTR is reviewed and signed off by ExTL which has the agreement with ATF
- ExTR is endorsed by ExCB
- ExTR is issued by ExTL

- ExTR is drafted by ATF, including assessment of compliance with standards (within scope)
- ExTR is reviewed and signed off by ExTL which does not have agreement with ATF
- ExTR is endorsed by ExCB
- ExTR is issued by ExCB

- ExTR is drafted by non-IECEx body, based on testing done
- ExTL does assessment to standards, reviews testing and compiles and signs the ExTR
- ExTR is endorsed by ExCB
- ExTR is issued by ExTL

- ExTL reviews manufacturer and signs agreement according to OD 024
- ExTL accepts tests from manufacturer without witnessing testing, and compiles and signs the ExTR
- ExTR is endorsed by ExCB
- ExTR is issued by ExTL

- ExTL tests, or witnesses tests, on samples of Ex e motors from a range
- Manufacturer supplies data for other motors on temperature rise, time t and starting current ratio I_A/I_N.
- ExTR includes whole range of motors, including above data
- ExTR is endorsed by ExCB
- ExTR is issued by ExTL

ExTL vs ExCB

Test sample

- Tests at ExTL
- Tests by ExTL at manufacturer
- Manufacturer's data per standard

Additional item(s) in range

- Data from tests by manufacturer
- Data from calculations by manufacturer

ExTL vs ExCB

Decision on compliance according to 17025, IECEx rules Test sample and ODs, supported by third party test data **IECE**x CoC Additional item(s) in Decision on compliance based range on judgement, supported by first party test data
