Call for members to CAB Working Group: Cyber Security

BACKGROUND

Following the report from the CAB ad hoc Group on Functional Security, CAB/1265/R, and the CAB Decision 35/8 (given below), taken at the recent CAB meeting held on 2014-06-16, a new working group, WG 17 – Cyber Security, has been created with Mr Ron Collis as convenor.

Decision 35/8 — CAB WG 17 - Cyber Security

The CAB, recognises the need for additional evaluation / consideration of cyber security opportunities across the IEC and its CA Systems, decides to create a new working group, WG 17 with Mr Ron Collis as convenor, to investigate the market needs for possible CA services in Cyber Security, and tasked to report back to CAB at its next meeting in November.

The participants of the former ad hoc Group will be invited to participate in this working group.

Other participants being solicited for participation should also come from the following groups:

- Certification bodies
- Manufacturing Industry
- Regulators
- Systems Integrators within the IEC Standards Community.

First meeting will take place on 21 August 2014 in London.
