In 2007, he became member of the French delegation to ExMC and since this date he is an active member of many IECEx Working Groups. He is also an IECEx Lead Assessor for IECEx 02, 04 and 05.

Regarding the standardisation, he is Chairman of the French TC31, Convener of MT80079-34, Project Leader of PT80079-36 and member of many IEC TC 31 Maintenance Teams. He was also the Project Leader of the first ISO/IEC standard in the Explosive Atmosphere field, the ISO/IEC 80079-34 dealing with Quality System for Ex Equipment manufacture. In 2011, for his active contribution he received the IEC 1906 Award.
